

CHAPTER 97: PARKS AND RECREATION

§ 97.99 PENALTY.

(A) Any person, company, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of § 97.01 shall be punished as provided by the "P-ticket" provisions of § 10.99. However, the P-ticket method of enforcement shall be only be available for the first three violations of § 97.01. In the event that a person has already been issued three P-tickets, whether convicted or not, then the fine for violating § 97.01 shall be not less than \$75 nor more than \$750 for each offense.

(B) Any person violating § 97.02 shall be fined not less than \$25 nor more than \$200 for each offense upon conviction thereof.

§ 97.01 PARK HOURS.

No person shall utilize any of the facilities of the village parks, or park any motor vehicle in any of the village parks, except during the following hours:

(A) From April 1 through October 31, between the hours of 6 a.m. and 10 p.m. (CST);

(B) From November 1 through March 31, between the hours of 6 a.m. and 8 p.m. (CST);

(C) The restrictions set forth in divisions (A) and (B) above shall apply to all lighted activity courts of the village; provided, however, that the baseball fields may remain open until the conclusion of all league sanctioned activities.

§ 97.02 DAMAGE TO PARK PROPERTY.

No person shall cut, break, climb on, or in any way injure or deface any tree shrub, plant, turf, or any of the buildings, fences, bridges, lamps, posts or other structure or property within the village parks.
